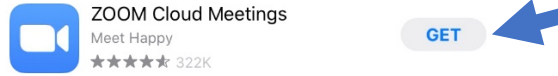


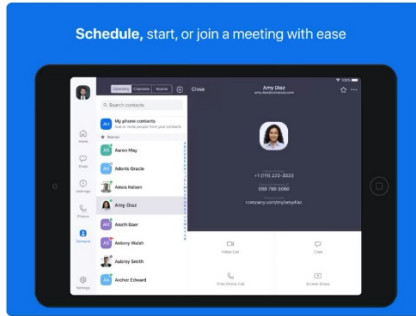
Connecting to Zoom on an iPad

1. Make sure you have the Zoom App installed.

- a. To install the App, open the App Store on your iPad:
- b. In the App Store, search for Zoom App:

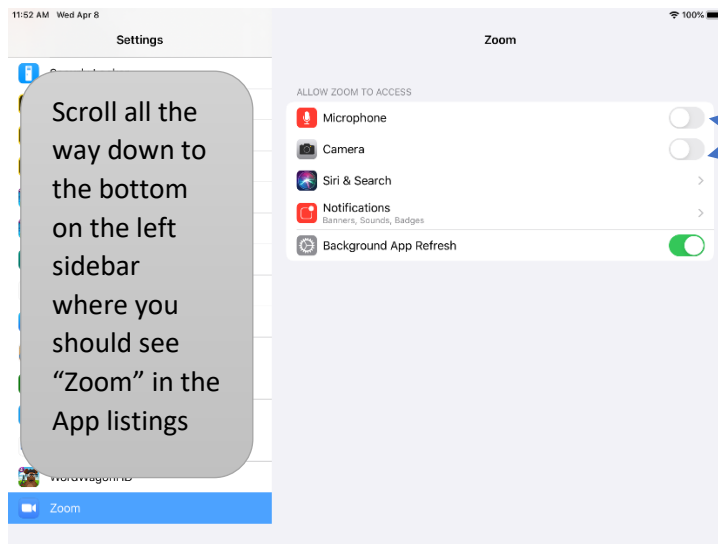
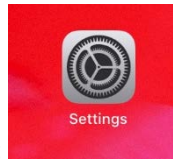


Select "Get" to download the App.



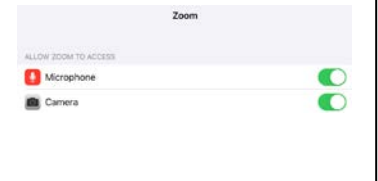
2. Once the App is installed, check your settings to guarantee that you will be able to connect.

- a. Open the Settings Menu on the iPad:

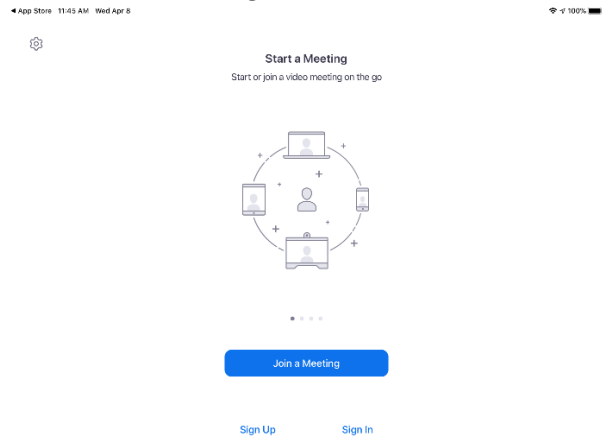
Turn on both microphone and camera.

They should look like this:



3. Now you are ready to connect to your Zoom Call!

- a. Open Zoom 
- b. Select Join a Meeting:



- c. Enter your meeting details:

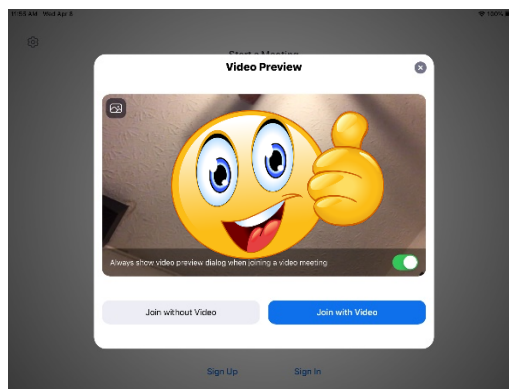


Enter your Meeting ID here

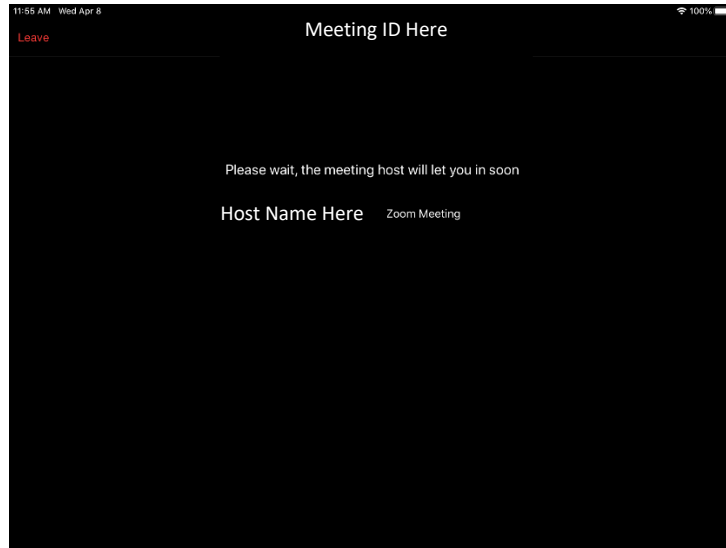
Enter your name here (this is what people will see when you join the room)

Select Join

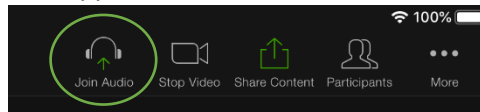
- d. You will be given the opportunity to preview your video (you should see yourself!), and can choose to Join with or without Video:



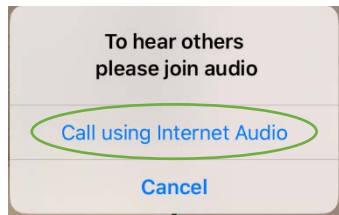
- e. You will then enter the “Waiting Room.” Wait here until a meeting host allows you to enter the room.



- 4. Once you are in the meeting, you need to connect to meeting audio.
 - a. Tap the screen to make the menu appear.

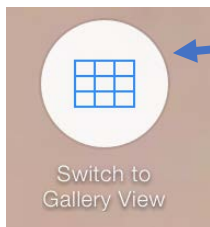
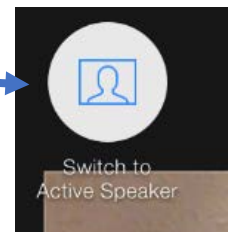


- b. Select the Join Audio Button:
 - c. Select Call using Internet Audio



- d. You are now fully connected.
- 5. If you want to change your view from the view that you currently have, then tap your screen and select the view you desire to see.

*Active Speaker – shows one participant, the one that is recognized as the active speaker.



*Gallery View – Shows multiple participants (up to 9) on the iPad screen.

* You can swipe Right to Left to see more people in each view.
